## **Code Red**

The Yavapai County Sheriff's Office now utilizes **CodeRED®** as its **Emergency Notification System**. With this service, we can send messages to residents and businesses within minutes containing specific information when an emergency or time-sensitive issue arises.

Although ENS does contain published landline phone number information by default, we may only get landline phone data updates twice a year. This is why it is vital that you register all your phone numbers directly to assure contact in an emergency.

By signing up, you also have the ability to enter alternate phone numbers and/or modes of contact. You may also specify your primary contact mode. The opt-in process will require that you have a valid email address. A confirmation email and/or text message will be sent upon completion of registration. This message will be sent from [noreply@ycsoaz.gov](mailto:noreply@ycsoaz.gov) and may take up to 5 minutes. Once registered, you may opt-out at any time. When delivery of the alert to your primary contact fails, the system will automatically fall back to other methods. If the system detects an answering machine, it will deliver the message to voicemail. If there is no answer, the system will redial the number at a later time or, if specified, fall back to another contact mode.
