### *Congress Stabbing Suspect being Sought*

On January 8, 2014, at approximately 9:15 PM, YCSO deputies were dispatched to a stabbing incident in the 22000 block of Painted Acres Lane, Congress. Deputies contacted a 22-year-old victim who explained his brother, 24-year-old Anthony Russell Lamon Jr., had stabbed him in the back and slashed his left arm with a hunting knife during an argument. Following the assault, the victim ran to a neighbor's residence on Clydesdale to seek help as he was bleeding profusely. The victim thought his brother might still be inside their home. The victim noted that as he ran from the home, his brother was grabbing a hatchet intending to continue the assault.

The victim was treated at the scene and airlifted to a Phoenix hospital.

Deputies searched the home on Painted Acres Lane and discovered Anthony had fled. It was later determined the victim's injuries were not life threatening and he has since been released from the hospital to recover. According to medical personnel, some stab wounds came very close to vital organs and considering the circumstances, the victim was fortunate.

During the initial investigation, deputies were told by a family member that Anthony was planning to visit his grandmother who was being treated in a Phoenix area hospital (not the same hospital where his brother was treated). Deputies notified the hospital of Anthony's potential arrival. The next day, deputies were contacted by the Maricopa County Sheriff's Office and they confirmed Anthony was seen attempting to visit his grandmother but fled when hospital security approached him. **He was last seen driving a white 2006 Jeep Grand Cherokee belonging to his grandmother.**

**Deputies have obtained a \$100,000 Assault Warrant for Anthony Russell Lamon Jr. If anyone has information as to his whereabouts, please contact YCSO at 928-771-3260 or Yavapai Silent Witness at 1800-932-3232.
